

How to Remove Paint From a Bamboo Table

A paint stain on a piece of wood furniture can be an eyesore. Fortunately, there are a few tricks you can use to remove paint from most types of wood furniture. If you need to remove paint from a bamboo table, the following steps will help guide you

1. Step 1

Wrap a cloth rag around the plastic putty knife. Use the plastic putty knife to scrape away as much of the dried paint as possible. Make sure the rag is secure around the plastic putty knife so it can act as a buffer to prevent you from scratching the bamboo table.

2. Step 2

Use a razor blade to delicately scratch away any remaining dried paint. Use great care, and take your time to prevent damaging the table.

3. Step 3

Open the container of mineral spirits. Apply a small amount of mineral spirits to a dry cloth rag. Use your fingers and thumb to gently massage the area stained with paint. Continue rubbing away the paint until all of it has been removed from the bamboo table.
